Classes 46 and 47 \$20 per horse/rider combo
Warm up (time permitting) \$30

**No entry will be allowed to pick up their numbers without showing a
current Coggins test.**

**An open check, or credit card on file is needed before numbers will be
issued to exhibitors.**

**DIVISIONS DESCRIPTIONS
(V denotes VHSA, B denotes BHSA)**

SCHOOLING HUNTER – Open to all horses and ponies. Fences 2'6" or 2'9", rider's choice. **(B)**

WORKING HUNTER – Open to horses only. Fences 2'9" or 3', rider's choice. **(V,B)**
Farm Trophy will not be awarded in a combined class if a Child is not the winner.

LEADLINE – Open to riders 7 & under. May not enter any class that requires a trot. To
be judged 50% on rider and 50% on suitability of mount. **(B)**

SHORT STIRRUP HUNTER: Open to riders 12 and under. Cross-entry of both
Horse/Pony and rider not allowed in any VHSA recognized division with the exception of
Equitation on the flat and Pleasure per VHSA rules. Fences 18". **(V)**

SHORT/LONG STIRRUP EQUITATION: Short- 12 and under. Long- 13 and up. Fences
18". May not cross enter into any classes that have fences higher than 18". **(B)**

HORSE PLEASURE – Open to all. Will be combined if entries warrant. **(V,B)**

PONY PLEASURE – Open to all ponies ridden by juniors. **(V,B)**

LOW HUNTER – Open to all horses and ponies. Simple courses. Fences 2' or 2'3". **(B)**

PONY/GREEN PONY HUNTER – Open to ponies ridden by juniors. Fences 2' for Small
Ponies, 2'3" for Medium Ponies and 2'6" for Large Ponies. **(V,B)**

LIMIT RIDER HUNTER – Open to horses and ponies ridden by Juniors or Adult/Amateurs
who are not entered in any BHSA recognized classes jumping 2'6" or higher. Fences 2'
or 2'3". May be combined with Low Hunter if there are not enough entries. **(B)**

RULES – PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

- This show is a VHSA and BHSA Associate Horse Show.
- Pre-entries must be received by 12 PM, Monday, September 28, 2026. Post entries will be accepted, time permitting, and entries may be limited to fit time schedule.
- \$20 Office Fee will be charged for each horse. **\$25 office fee for any horses entered after the closing date of entries.**
- One warm up per horse allowed without approval from management. Warm up to run all day including Hunt Night TIME PERMITTING. Management reserves the right to cancel Warm Ups if needed.
- No schooling breaks on the day of the horse show. See schedule for schooling on Friday.
- CURRENT NEGATIVE COGGINS REQUIRED
- Schooling permitted morning of the show until 6:45 AM. (Short Stirrup schooling from 6:45 until 7AM)
- Food will be available on the grounds.
- All riders must wear ASTM approved headgear at all times when mounted.
- Waiver must be signed before numbers will be handed out. Neither KHC nor their employees and agents will be responsible for accident, injury, or loss of property on the show grounds.
- Any dogs on the show grounds, including lower ring, must be on leash and under control at all times.
- Ponies may be ridden by adults in the Schooling Hunter and Low Hunter divisions.

NUMBERS CAN BE PICKED UP ON FRIDAY.

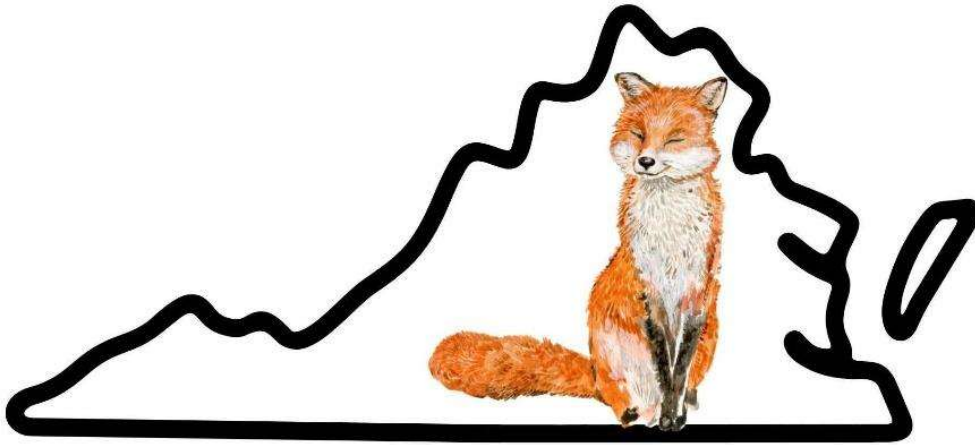
ALL HORSES SCHOOLING MUST CHECK IN AT SHOW OFFICE BEFORE SCHOOLING.
